Minutes of the 2024-3/28th Meeting of the Board of Governors of IISER Berhampur

1. Opening remarks of the Chairperson

The Chairperson welcomed the members present at the 28th meeting of the BoG of IISER Berhampur. After a brief introduction of all members and his opening remarks, he requested the Secretary, BoG to present the agenda items.

2. Overview report of the Director, IISER Berhampur on the activities of the Institute

An overview report was presented by the Director. The BoG was updated on the academic activities, status of the construction of the permanent campus, the financial status, important activities of the Institute, and the status of the human resource (teaching and non-teaching). The overview report was earlier shared with the BoG. The Director's Overview Report is enclosed at **Annexure-A**.

The Director mentioned about the difficulty and challenges being faced in the functioning of the Institute due to inadequate number of regular faculty and non-teaching staff and requested the MoE representatives to expedite the process for sanction of faculty and non-teaching positions for the Institute. Further, he requested to expedite the appointment of Chairperson, and some other members of BoG which are vacant.

3. Confirmation of the Minutes of the 2024-2/27th Meeting of the BoG, IISER Berhampur held on June 26, 2024

The BoG resolved to confirm the minutes of the 2024-2/27th meeting held on Jun 26, 2024 with the following comments of the MoE, which will form part of the original minutes:

- (a) **Resolution No. 23:** It appears Equipment and ICT heads are different as approved by Cabinet/MoE. The expenditure cannot be shifted between different Heads; it has to be fixed under a particular Head, with approvals and justifications. Once the expenditure is fixed under a

particular Head, it has to remain under that Head. Therefore, it was suggested in the meeting to address the duplicity in the sanction Heads first, to arrive at the actual funds available under a given Head.

- (b) **General Comment:** MoE informed that the request sent by the institute for sanction of additional cost is incomplete as all the buildings are still not complete. On account of this, the additional cost may be higher than shared by the institute. Therefore, the sanction of additional cost could only be dealt with once all the buildings/services are complete. This has been informed to the institute in multiple discussions, including FC/BoG meetings.

17. To consider and approve the addendum to the existing approved Faculty Career Advancement Scheme (FCAS)

IFD Comments: Where flexi Cadre structure is in place, can a separate FCAS be implemented? Considered view of the Technical Bureau, MoE may be taken.

MoE Comments: May be noted.

The BoG resolved to approve the following addendum to the FCAS as "Other conditions of the FCAS" under para 4.6 (before appendix):

Para 4.6- Other Conditions:

- I. The process of faculty career advancement under the FCAS will be carried out once every year.
- II. The cut of date for determining institute level minimum eligibility and evaluation criteria for advancement as provided under Para-2 of the Scheme will be 28th February of each Year for all purposes.
- III. Every year, applications for consideration under the said scheme shall be invited from the eligible faculty members preferably in the first week of the March every year. Applications received shall be expeditiously processed by the Institute as per the Scheme as approved by the BoG.
- IV. Faculty selected for career advancement under FCAS shall be given the offer for the higher post effective from 28th February of the same year.
- V. In case of doubt or interpretation of the any of the provision of the Scheme, the decision of the BoG based on the recommendation of the Director will be final.
- VI. The Institute will hold the selection process as per the said scheme once in a year preferably during March/April every year. In case, the Selection process will not be held due to any reason, the eligibility as mentioned at (a) above, will remain same.

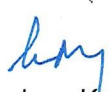
